GOALS OF SCHOOL VISITS

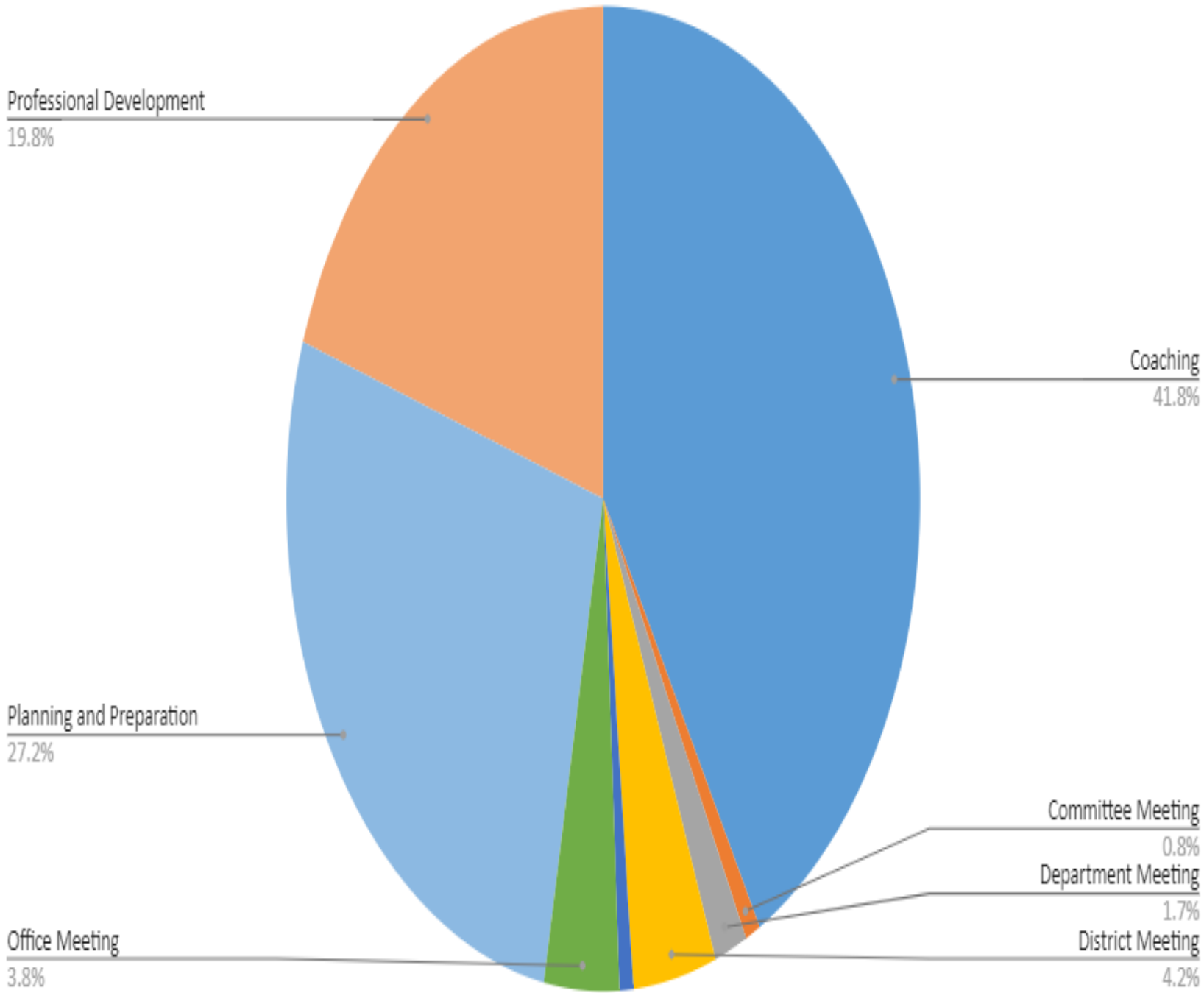
- Support schools with data analysis

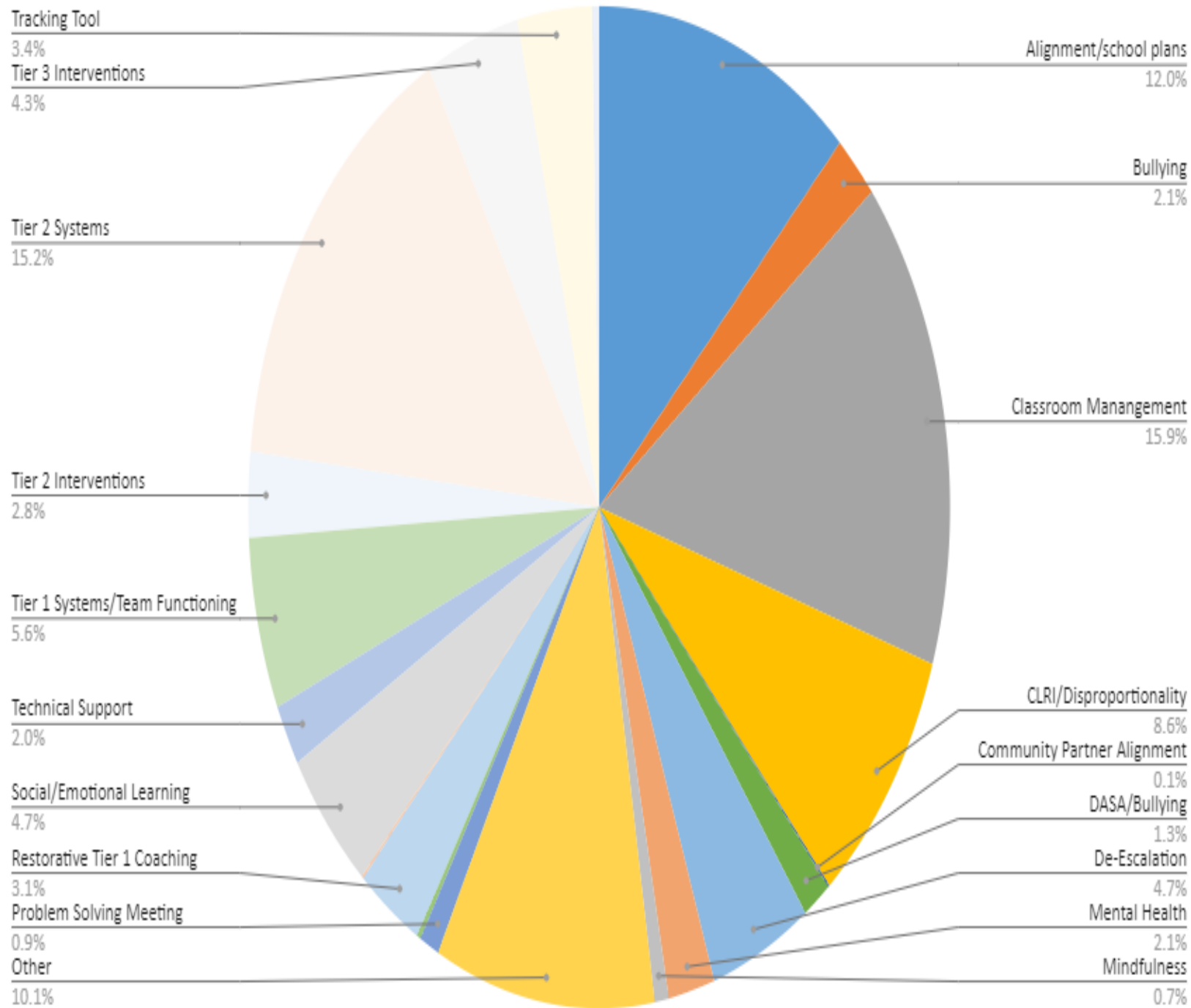
