


### **COHORT 2020**

GOAL 3 - THE PERCENTAGE OF "UNOFFICIAL" 4-YEAR GRADUATION COHORT STUDENTS WHO COMPLETE STATE AND DISTRICT GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS WILL REMAIN CONSISTENT FROM 79.1% IN JUNE 2023 TO 79.1% IN JUNE 2024.

# 2020 COHORT DEFINITION

Entered Grade 9 any time during the 2020-2021 School Year



### March 2020 (8th Grade)

The Pandemic forced all students into remote learning. Cohort 2020 completed 8th grade while on remote learning.

### **2020 - 2021 School Year (**9th Grade)

Hybrid instruction was phased in beginning February 2021 Many Cohort 2020 students remained on remote learning.

## **2021-2022 School Year(in-person instruction,**10th grade)

Many Cohort 2020 students received in person instruction for the first time since 8th grade (students were in their second year of high school).

State and local COVID isolation and quarantine mandates: High rates of COVID 10-14 days of isolation or quarantine.

Impacted both students and school personnel

- United States History (1 credit required)
- Participation in Government (½ credit required)
- Economics (½ credit required)




