



### KINDERGARTEN COMPOSITE






DIBELS 8 is a universal screening measure. The level of difficulty of each test remains the same, but the cut score for proficiency increases with each Benchmark assessment.






### FIRST GRADE COMPOSITE






### **GRADE 2 COMPOSITE**






#### **iReady**

- Diagnostic: The primary function of iReady is to make appropriate instructional recommendations for students performing at different levels.
- Adaptive: As students answer questions correctly, the test becomes more difficult. As students answer questions incorrectly, the test becomes easier.


- Student performance is measured on a scale of 100–800, with students' current score indicating that they have mastered skills up to that point and still need to work on the skills beyond that point.
- It is reasonable to expect that a student early in the fall semester may not have received instruction in some grade-level content. i-Ready placements are conservative, and instructional recommendations are focused on providing teachers with actionable data that can be helpful in the classroom.


#### **Typical Growth**
