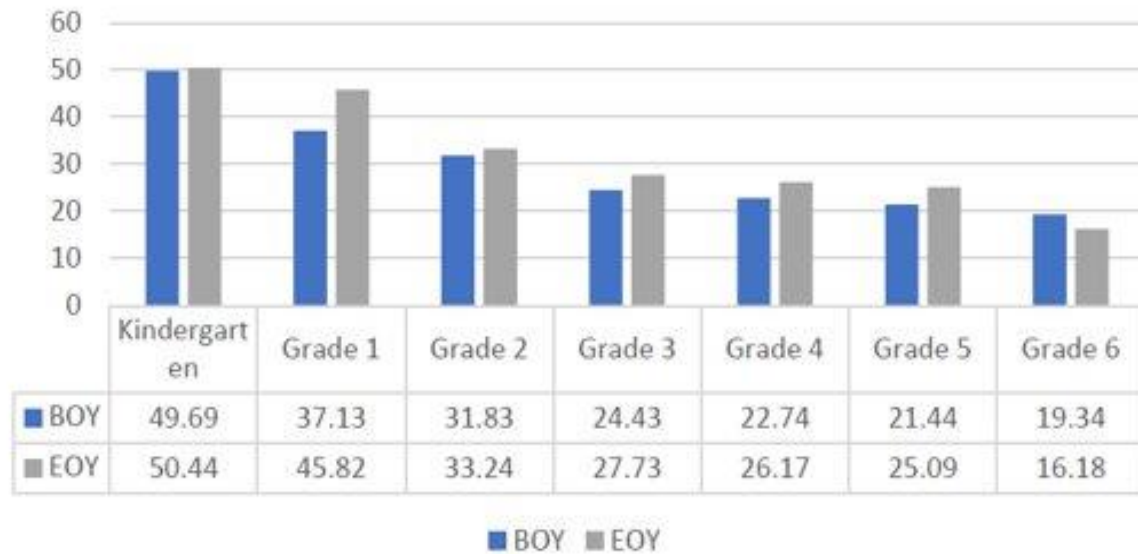

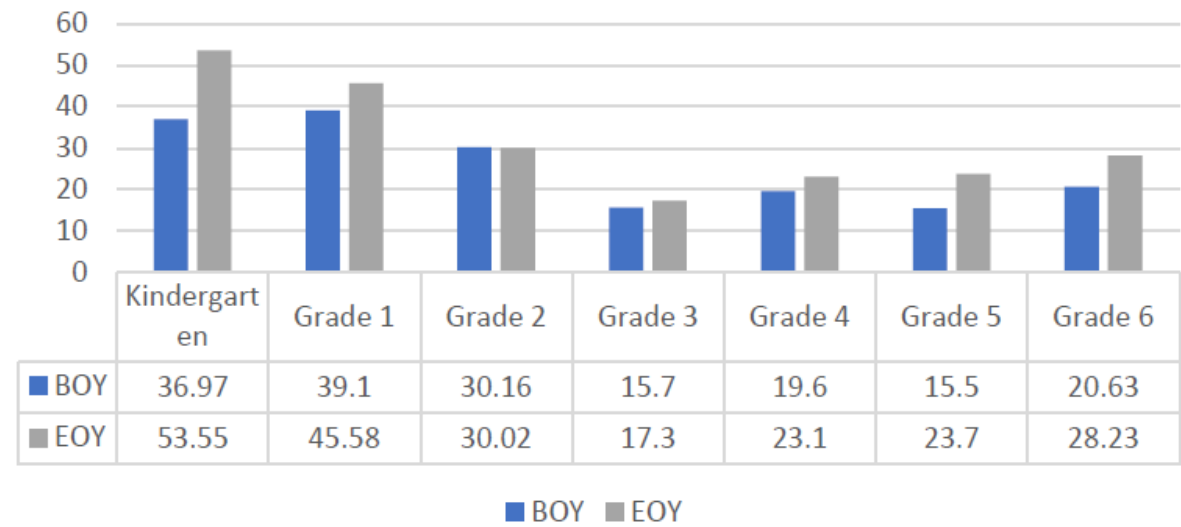
PK-6 Summer Reading and Mathematics Test Results

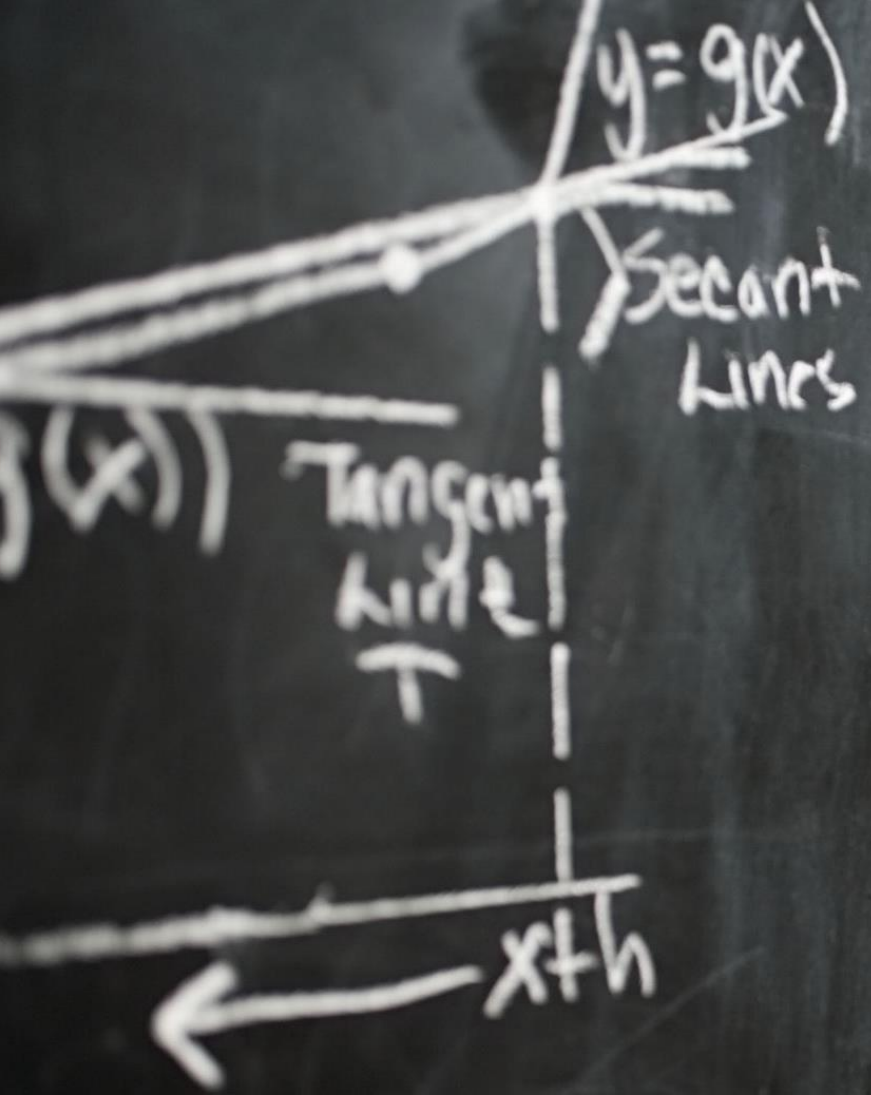
Students completed a test at the beginning and end of the program.

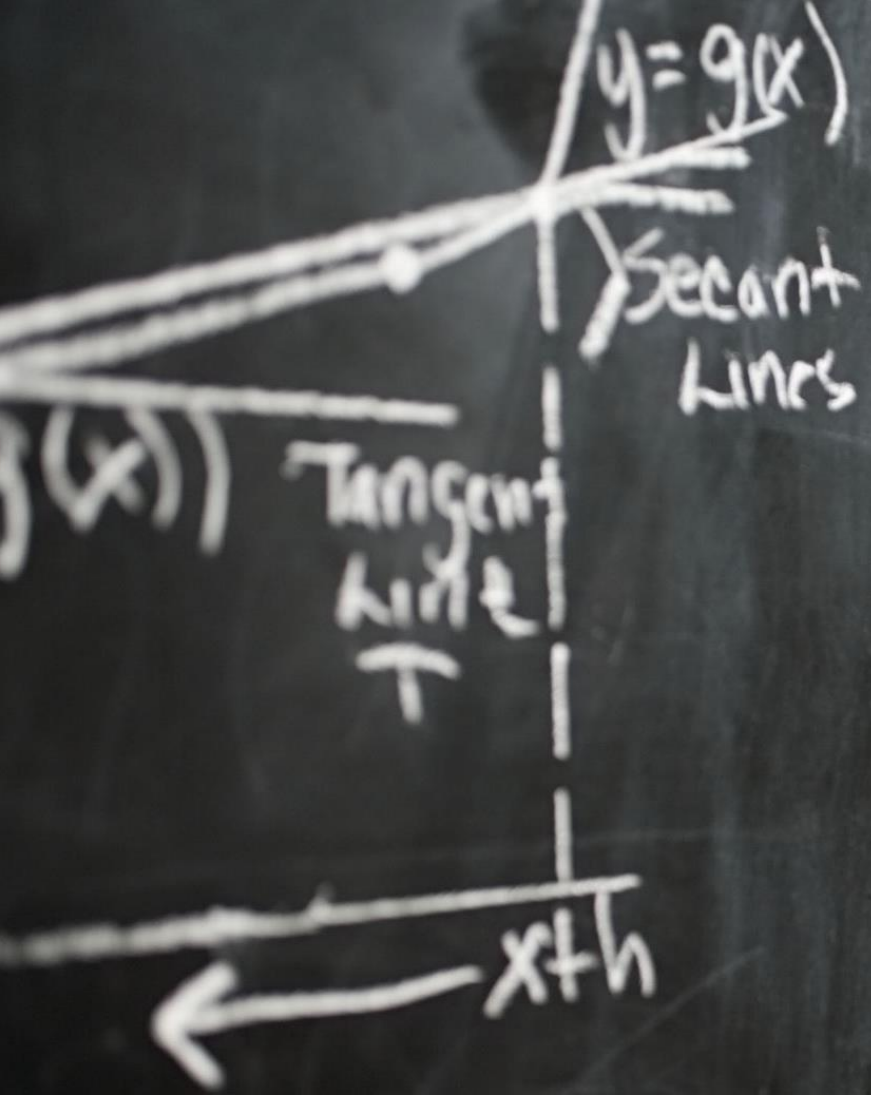
